

# COMMUNICATING HEALTH NUTRITION PROGRAM

Seva Asmakam Dharmah Charitable trust is a top non profit and non government organization in India working towards the taking care of health, nutrition of women, children and young people.

Seva askamak dharmah charitable trust objective of this workshop was to raise awareness about the importance of nutrition for overall health and well-being, particularly among pregnant women and young children in the target community.

## Nutrition for education

Malnutrition slows a child's development and makes them vulnerable to a number of illnesses. The UN's Standing Committee on Nutrition (SCN) has identified malnutrition as the largest single contributor to disease in the world. Left untreated, malnutrition can inhibit the physical and cognitive development of children and lead to lifelong consequences.



The nutrition project under SADCT TRUST's Mission Education programme outlines an investment in the next generation by highlighting nourishment as a core focus area. The project incorporates evidence-based nutrition interventions, as well as integrates nutrition goals into broader efforts in critical areas such education, sanitation and health, broadly under two categories:

**a) Nutrition Support:** Catering to nutritional needs of the underprivileged children

**b) Nutrition Awareness:** Sensitising the underprivileged communities towards the issue of malnutrition amongst children, mothers and family members

## WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY (ADOPT TREE)

Seva Asmakam Dharmah Charitable Trust objective of the environmental conservation campaign was to raise awareness about the importance of protecting the environment, engage the community in conservation efforts, and implement practical initiatives to mitigate environmental degradation. The objective of the menstrual hygiene management program was to promote awareness about menstrual health and hygiene, provide access to affordable menstrual products, and empower women and girls to manage their periods safely and with dignity

### Education and Awareness Workshops:

- o Conducted educational workshops in schools, community centers, and women's groups to raise awareness about menstruation, menstrual hygiene, and reproductive health.
- o Covered topics such as menstrual cycle basics, menstrual hygiene practices, common myths and misconceptions, and the importance of using hygienic menstrual products.
- o Facilitated open discussions and Q&A sessions to address participants' questions, concerns, and experiences related to menstruation.

## SANITARY PAD DISTRIBUTION



### Improving menstrual hygiene

Knowledge about menstruation and hygienic habits are curtailed by stigma and taboos in the Indian society, where talking about period is not allowed.

Seva Asmakam Dharmah Charitable Trust is tackling the very issue of menstrual hygiene

management at its roots. Working within the Rural areas and low income communities, SEVA ASMAKAM DHARMAH CHARITABLE TRUST is helping to raise awareness around menstruation and in bringing affordable sanitary products directly

to the women in need. By manufacturing low cost high quality sanitary napkins, more affordable than them on a door-to-door scheme

At Seva Asmakam Dharmah Charitable Trust, Girl program was kick-started on the

occasion of Women's Day on 8th of March. The motive behind this was not only to equip girls from an underprivileged

background with proper menstrual products but also to impart

knowledge through training on menstrual hygiene management.

- Distributed educational materials, pamphlets, and brochures containing practical tips and guidelines for maintaining good health
